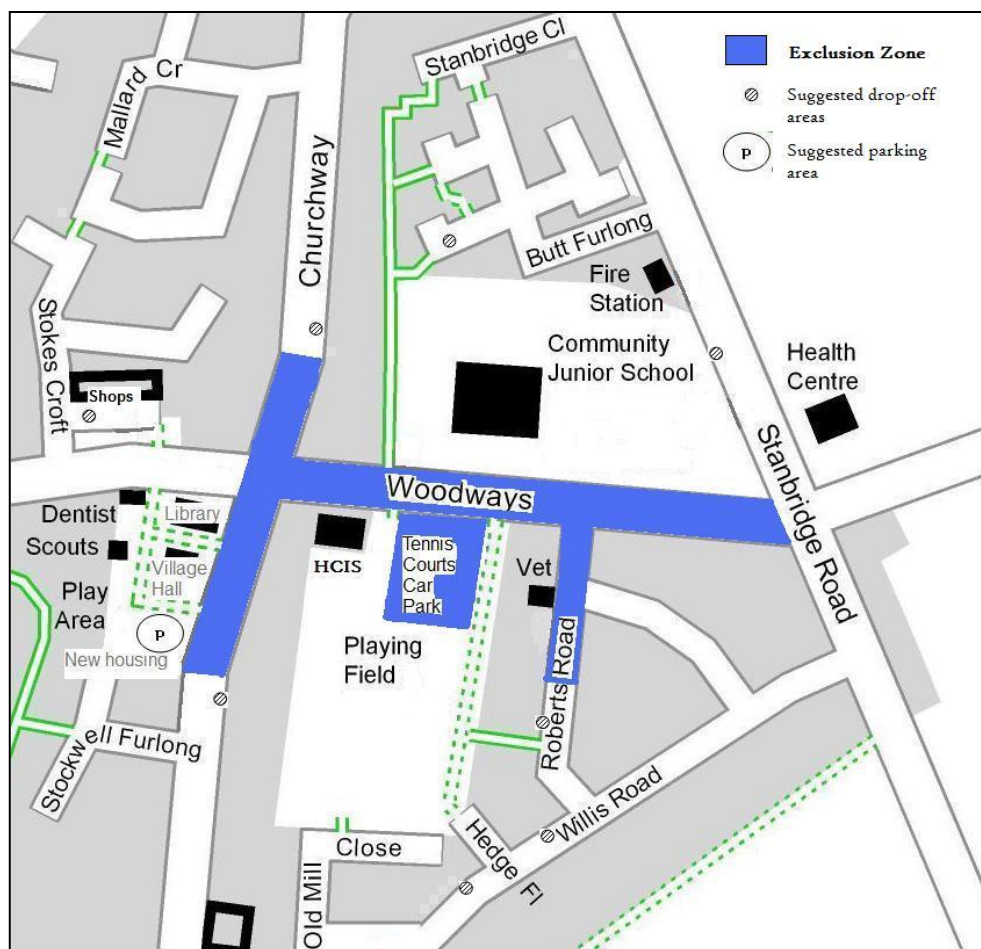


Walk to School Week Oct 17-21

October 2011 is International Walk to School Month when about 40 countries promote walking to school. See www.walktoschool.org.uk for more information and resources. Next week we'd like you to do your bit just for 5 days! Please walk at least part of the way to school during this period even if you have to drive into Haddenham. Children will have a sheet to sign in each class if they have walked and we may have a small reward for the class who have walked the most.

We also ask you to avoid driving in our Exclusion Zone if possible to make the area near to the school safer for pedestrians and cyclists.



When parking or dropping off please think carefully about the safety of others:

- **Do not** block driveways
- Check for cyclists, pedestrians or other cars **before** opening doors.
- Encourage children to exit/enter the car on the side of the pavement and not into the road.
- **Do not** drop off in the school lay-by

20s Plenty for Haddenham

The Junior School also supports the campaign to establish a 20 mph speed limit throughout Haddenham. We have had strong support for this in all four of our Travel Surveys. Evidence from 20 mph zones shows that, even if the limit is not legally enforceable, most people drive well below 30 mph so that if there is an accident it is much less likely to be fatal.
