Y5 Cycle Training - would you like this to be provided?

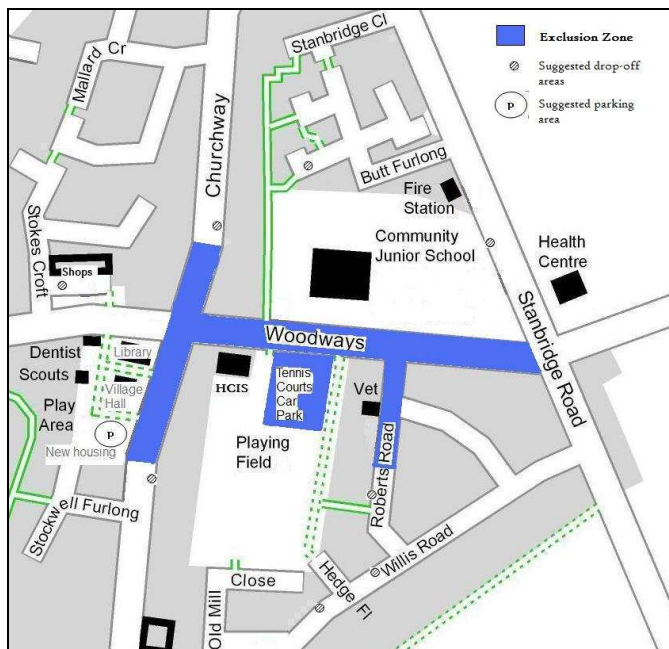
If there is sufficient demand for a Year 5 on-road cycle course Haddenham Cycle Training will organise more cycle training during the summer term; please contact the school if you are interested.

Walk & Wheels Wednesdays

This term, in place of *Go for Gold*, we are trying out a new scheme on Wednesdays to try to reduce congestion in Woodways and make children's journeys to school safer. All children can take part as long as they travel to school by bus or walk, scoot or cycle **from outside the Exclusion Zone**, Woodways and the near ends of Roberts Road and Churchway.



Children who travel to school in this way will get a mark for their house which will help to colour in big Olympic rings of the same colour. There will be separate competitions for the north and south areas to see which house can complete its Olympic ring first, over ten weeks before Easter.

If you drive into Haddenham please do not drive along Woodways on Wednesdays. Parking and dropping off places are suggested on the map, so please leave home a little bit earlier, so you can take a slightly longer route to avoid Woodways.
